Driving directions to Greenleaf Art Center

1806 West Greenleaf Ave., Chicago, IL 60626

Greenleaf Art Center (GAC) is located on Chicago's far north side in Rogers Park. The art center has a parking lot on the East side of the building which is only accessable from the back alley. To gain entrance take Wolcott St between Greenleaf and Estes.

Directions from downtown Chicago (lakefront):

Travel Lake Shore Drive north to its end. Stay in the right hand lanes, turning right to continue northbound on Sheridan Rd. Follow Sheridan as it curves west around Loyola University (6200N) for three blocks and then turns northward again. Travel under the Loyola "el" train station and continue north 8 blocks to Greenleaf Ave (7100N) turn left (west) on Greenleaf. Continue going west past Clark Street and under the Metra train viaduct. Greenleaf Art Center is on the northside of the street.

Directions from Chicago's north/west side:

Take Ashland Ave northbound. Just north of Andersonville Ashland Ave and Clark St. merge. Continue on Clark St to Greenleaf Ave (7100N), turn left going west. Travel under the Metra train viaduct, Greenleaf Art Center is on the north-side of the street.

Directions from northern suburbs:

Travel I-94 East (south) to Touhy Ave exit. East on Touhy (7200N) for approx. 4 miles, cross McCormick, continue accross Western (2400W) to Ridge Ave. At Ridge Ave. turn right (south) the second street is Greenleaf. Turn left on Greenleaf (east), continue on Greenleaf to 1806 West Greenleaf.

Public Transportation:

Greenleaf Art Center is located in Rogers Park one block west of Clark on Greenleaf Avenue. It is conveniently located at the Rogers Park Metra train stop, is about 5 blocks west of the Morse "el" train stop and is easily accesible via the #22 Clark Street bus.
