### **Painting & Drawing Materials List**

Please note that it is not necessary or even recommended that you buy the most expensive art supplies. “Student Grade” of any brand is fine, and “hue” substitutes are also fine in place of actual cadmium or cobalt colors, which are far more expensive. If you find sets of paints with additional colors that is great, but not necessary. If you already have some paint start with that. The following list are just suggestions.

#### **Paints:**

Oil or Acrylic, choose one paint medium to start with, either is fine.

Colors:

Red: Cadmium Red (medium), Alizarin Crimson

Green: Permanent Green

Blue: Ultramarine Blue, Cerulean Blue, Cobalt Blue

Cadmium Yellow (Medium & Light), Naples Yellow, Yellow Ochre

Titanium White, Zinc White

Mars Black

#### **Palette & Palette knife:**

A palette and knife for mixing paints.

White, smooth, flat surface. Paper tear off sheet palettes are the best option.

#### **Solvent:**

For oil painting: Odorless Turpenoid plus two small jars (baby food jars or similar size jars)

#### **Brushes**

At least three, one each of thick, fine, and medium; round or filbert shapes. Moderate priced brushes are good.

#### **Misc.**

Paper towels or rags

Receptacle for holding water and brushes.

#### **Paint on**

2 or 3 stretched canvases or canvas boards, 12” x 16”

#### **Drawing supplies**

Inexpensive newsprint sketch pad, at least 10” x 12”

Pencils, charcoal sticks kneaded eraser

And anything else you like to draw with!
